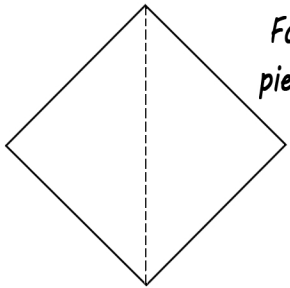
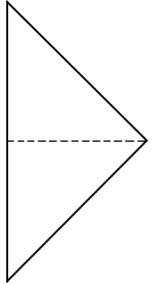


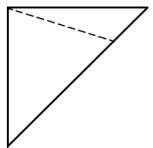
**Make an Origami BUTTERFLY!**



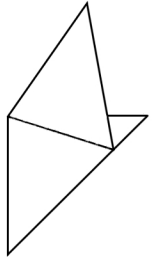
Fold a square piece of paper in half.



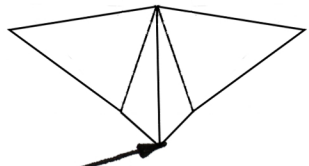
Fold in half again.



Make first wing by folding one corner upward along dotted line



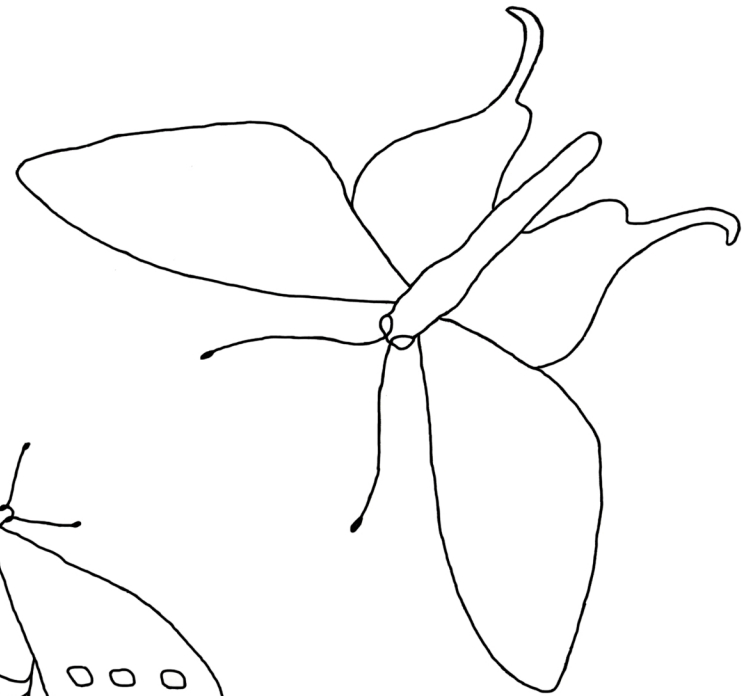
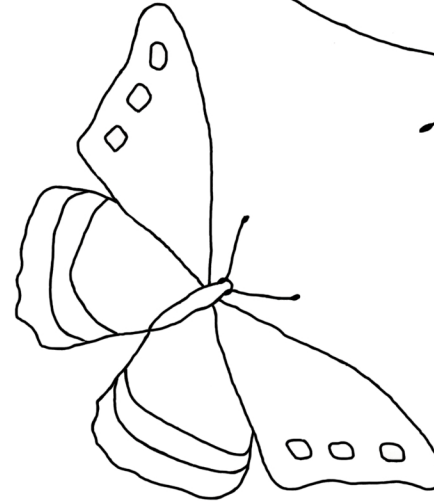
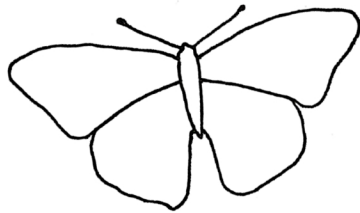
Fold second wing up



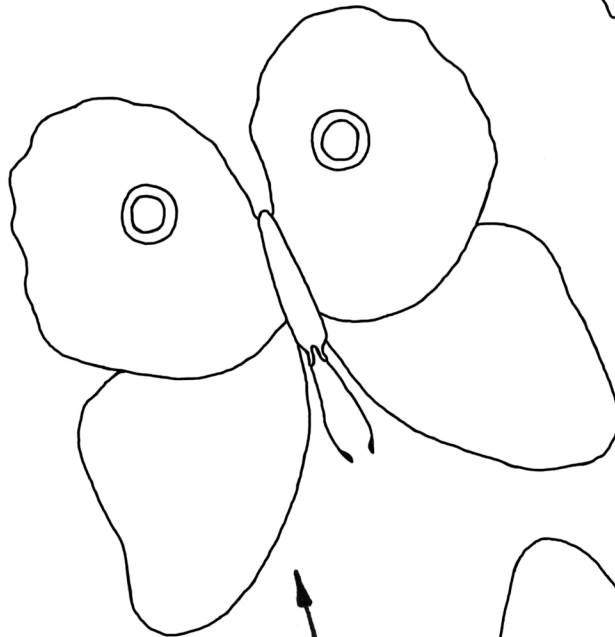
Press here to make your butterfly flap its' wings.
